To dispose of properly, at no charge, call the HHW Facility at 785-286-4381.</li><li>4) <b>For everyone's safety, hypodermic needles should be put in hard-pack containers, i.e., bleach bottles, ketchup bottles, etc. before being placed in the trash.</b></li><li>5) Dirt, rock, and concrete cannot be disposed of with household refuse. Call the Solid Waste office at 785-233-4774 to make other arrangements.</li><li>6) Personal containers must be no more than 32 gallons, have handles, and not weigh more than 65 lbs.</li><li>7) Non-county issued container: too heavy, fragile, or too cumbersome to empty.</li><li>8) For ease of handling, please place heavier items in your county issued cart.</li><li>9) Bagged waste should not exceed 45 lbs.</li><li>10) More than 15 bags of yard waste; 15 were taken.</li><li>11) For ease of handling, branches, shrubs, boards, and carpet should be cut and tied in bundles no longer than 4 feet, and 18 inches in diameter.</li><li>12) Human waste is not household refuse and is not accepted.</li><li>13) Holiday week. No bulky items. Household refuse and recycling only.</li><li>14) Material that is not considered household refuse can be picked up for a fee.
